SCHOOL ACCOUNTABILITY AND EDUCATIONAL OPTIONS NOTICE

According to State Statute, the School District of Hilbert is required to notify parents of the educational options available to children who reside in the resident school district. This requirement also requires notification of the school's accountability report. However, the Department of Public Instruction is prohibited from publishing an accountability report for schools this year. Due to these conflicting budget bill requirements, the School District of Hilbert will reference our most recent accountability report and current listing of educational options.
